



## Summary of Rules and Conditions for the Next Generation Training Workshop



The following is a summary of the rules, conditions, and eligibility governing participation in the Next Generation Training Workshops. GEOLAB is a starting community of Research Infrastructures for environmental and geotechnical research funded by the Horizon 2020 Research and Innovation programme.

PLEASE NOTE: This summary is a digest written by GEOLAB based on the Grant Agreement with the Commission, identifying the information that is most relevant to potential applicants.

1. Eligibility: Max. 4 years after MSc. or PhD degree at the time of application
2. Background in geotechnical design, analysis, maintenance, or operation of critical infrastructure
3. A selected group of persons will have the chance to attend the workshop at Norwegian Geotechnical Institute, Oslo.
4. Female candidates are strongly encouraged to apply (it is envisioned to have 50% female participation)
5. Funding for Travel and Subsistence (T&S) for 15 candidates will be available through the GEOLAB project. This funding will be assigned primarily to applicants outside of the GEOLAB consortium. Internal applicants will be considered for the T&S funding only when the training spots are not filled with external applicants.
6. Internal participants will be allowed without potential T&S funding from the GEOLAB project.
7. Participants can apply from any country within the European community (Horizon 2020) and associated states
8. Training participants are allowed to join the external workshops of the GEOLAB event
9. Deadline for application is **15<sup>th</sup> August 2023**.
